221 Tree Exemption Reports

Peak Lodge, Cotmaton Road, Sidmouth

The Planning Clerk reported a letter from East Devon District Council regarding the proposed works to fell a Sycamore tree.

The works in question are considered to be an exception from the normal requirement to seek the consent of the Council under Regulation 14 of the Town and County Planning (Tree Preservation) (England) Regulations 2012. (This regulation of the Act provides for works to be carried out on dead and dangerous trees [or parts of trees] in the interests of safety.)

There is a duty under the Act to plant replacement trees when trees are removed under this exception. In this instance, replanting will be required in the first planting season following removal (November to March). The tree should be a Lime with a minimum girth of 8-10 cms. This replacement tree will be covered by the existing Tree Preservation Order.
