50 Minutes

The minutes of the meeting of the Town Council held on Monday 2 July 2018 were signed as a true and accurate record.

51 Declarations of Interest

There were no Declarations of Interest received for this agenda.

52 Public Open Question Time

Five members of the public asked questions relating to the process for the sale of East Devon District Council Drill Hall site.

Responding to the questions, Councillors Turner and Barratt commented that the process being undertaken by EDDC, with the Town Council as consultee, was open and transparent and followed the usual procedure for the sale of a District Council asset including the advertising and selection criteria. Sensitive commercial material was only likely to be shared with potential bidders via EDDC's appointed agent JLL and not separately via the Town Council which was a third party within the process, as this could prejudice potential future bids both community and/or commercial.

Cllr Cole commented that the draft Neighbourhood Plan included residents' views regarding Drill Hall re-development, therefore any future planning applications should take notice of the Neighbourhood Plan. Cllr Barratt reported that the District Council's Development Management Committee had already referred to the Emerging Neighbourhood Plan with respect to a recent planning application therefore the Neighbourhood Plan was already in use as a planning tool.
