45 Matters of Urgency

- The Chairman reported that as the proposed bridge works at The Ham had been rescheduled to commence immediately after the August Bank Holiday; an additional request had been received from David Rowland Fun Fair to hold a fun fair on The Ham from Wednesday 21 August to Monday 26 August 2019 (excluding Sunday 25 August).

RESOLVED: that:

1. David Rowland Fun Fair be offered permission to hold a fun fair on The Ham from Tuesday 20 August to Friday 23 August 2019 inclusive.
2. The fun fair rides to be removed from The Ham on Saturday 24 August 2019 to enable public access to The Ham on Sunday 25 and Bank Holiday Monday 26 August 2019.
3. David Rowland Fun Fair must supply at least two security staff during their trading hours.

46 The Ham – Prayer Fest 2019 and 2020

Felicity Carver, Churchwarden, All Saints Church, Sidmouth had requested permission to use The Ham for a Prayer Fest event.

A group of churches would be taking part in a worldwide event called 'Thy Kingdom Come' which involved 10 days of prayer, between 30 May and 9 June. They were exploring the idea of holding a Prayer Fest on Saturday 1 June 2019 and Saturday 30 May 2020. They wished to set up in the morning and run the event from 1pm to 7pm which would be a free, fun afternoon open to everyone, where they planned to have a bouncy castle, games, Sidmouth Gospel Choir, gazebos for craft and prayers etc. They would not be selling anything, although they would like to offer some refreshments in the form of a BBQ and a pizza oven and would welcome any donations towards the cost of the food.

RESOLVED: That permission be granted to All Saints Church to use The Ham for a Prayer Fest event on Saturday 1 June 2019 and Saturday 30 May 2020.
