The Council hereby **refuses** permission to carry out work described below for the following reasons:

T6, Scots Pine: Cut back the limb overhanging the lane back to the main union at approximately 10 metres above ground level, diameter cut 200mm.

T7, Scots Pine: Dismantle in sections to near ground level.

1. The Scots pines (T6, T7 & T8) form a group which is visually significant, offering year round foliar interest in addition to decorative bark. The trees can be seen from Seafield Lane and Manor Road contributing to the amenity and character of the surrounding area.

There does not appear to be any signs of instability (ribbing, part failure, dieback or significant adaptive growth) in the limb identified for removal from T6, the removal of this limb would result in an unnecessary removal of foliage area and leave a large pruning wound on the main stem, initiating the formation of a decay column.

T7 forms a subdominant central part of the group, contributing to the groups lower canopy. Give this is a cohesive tree group loss of these lower branch may lead to instability in those branches above, especially those that rest in the crown of this tree from the Scots pine (T8). Its removal will impact on the adjacent street scene due to loss of lower canopy and stem and branch structure.

Final pruning cuts to be made at a side growth or back to parent branch or stem. In any event pruning cuts shall not exceed 100mm in diameter. (Reason - In the interests of amenity and to ensure the works are carried out in a satisfactory manner.)

Works:

Part 2, prune tree crowns back to boundary line.

 Pruning both tree groups back to the boundary would result in unattractive one sided trees, in the case of the Monterey cypress unlikely to ever re-establish a balanced crown form. These works would reduce the amenity value of the trees, reduced the privacy afforded by the trees to both development and possibly lead to tree instability.
