- 1. Forum formed Monday 21<sup>st</sup> March 2016 with a groupings and mutual introductions for the Steering Group members
- 2. First meeting took place, second meeting up-coming this Thursday
- 3. Boundary application has been approved on April 1st
- 4. Initial Steering Group roles simplified, next meeting April 14<sup>th</sup> at STC
- We are running a Schools competition around the design of an NP logo which will be used on all printed and electronic materials. Winning logo will be judged on Friday 27<sup>th</sup> April. Olympic rider and local celebrity Mary King to judge winner.
- 6. June 1<sup>st</sup> Information leaflet distributed in June with the One magazine.

- 9. From 19<sup>th</sup> July through August and ending on September 30<sup>th</sup>, analysis of Questionnaires and further PR at local events such as Folkweek etc

Redesign questionnaire for second round and drilling down into the questions that reflect most accurately the concerns of majority of residents of the Sid Valley.

The Steering Group are aiming to send out this second questionnaire on November 1<sup>st</sup> and collect them by 8<sup>th</sup> December. We will run another series of consultation events.

We are working on a funding application and you will be pleased to know that the Funding for the NP has been increased to £9,000. At this moment it is difficult to be precise about timing but the aim of the Steering Group is to be able to go to Referendum by September 2017
