6 Use of Salcombe Regis recreation Field

Rebecca Meakin, Interim Communities Manager, Landlord Services, East Devon District Council had written to request use of Salcombe Regis Recreation Ground on Thursday 22 August 2024, from 10am to 4pm, to hold an event for East Devon District Council Tenants.

EDDC asked to use the field to erect a small marquee and house other external stall holders, e.g. Young Devon, RAF, scouts and the local PCSO.

They anticipated a gathering of about 100, so a small section of the field may need to be used as an overspill for parking and some stall holders who will need vehicular access to set up stalls.

The Town Clerk advised Members that the scout group should not have given permission for use of the scout centre as this was not a young person or youth related event. He had contacted the scout group and reminded them of their lease agreement restrictions.

This request, therefore, was not only to use the field but also to use the scout centre.

RESOLVED: That permission be granted to East Devon District Council to use the scout centre and Salcombe Regis Recreation field for a Council Tenants event on Thursday 22 August from 10am to 4pm.
